

Setting up a club event

Club events have of standard range of courses in which the name (a colour) of the course denotes its difficulty.

Start O-Lynx Event

Setup the event

Select the “Events” tab, then “New Event”

Ensure the following

- **Event Date is actual day of the event** (if setting up before hand)
- SI5 time – can be left at the default 6 am
- Dictionary – set to “CLUB”. The club dictionary will set the colour of the title used for results.

When finished, the event setup should be similar to the example below, with just the date, code and description changed to suit.

Event Wizard

Enter the Event details.

When: 22/04/2018 12:00:00 AM * Set the time if you have more than one event on this day.

Event Code: CLUB1 * Unique code for the event.

Description: 2018 Club 1 *

Type: e.g. OY, CLUB.

Location: Map name.

Comments:

Group: Name used to group events together

O-Lynx Live ID: 0 Unique ID for uploading results to O-Lynxlive.com

Dictionary: CLUB

Download settings - when using O-Lynx to download chips.

SI5 time: 06:00:00 AM If you are using SI5 chips at this event, please set the SI5 time to 2 hours before the first start. If not using SI5 chips, this time can be ignored.

Start Priority: From Chip If a pre-assigned start time and chip start time both exist, select which one should be used.

Click “Next”, then “Finish” to exit the event wizard.

Import the courses

Go to the “Courses” tab and click the “IOF XML” button in the toolbar.

Find the coursedata V3 file (e.g. Club1_coursedata_v3.xml) as supplied by the course setter from Condes. Highlight the file and click “Open”.


Press “Import”

Check the codes used for the courses as the course setter may have used different ones when designing the courses in Condes.

Ideally they should be ...

WHITE, YELLOW, ORANGE, RS, RM, RL. – edit the course to change the code if necessary, as then they will be consistent with any saved result screen layouts.

The course screen should end up looking something like that below.
